SECOND GRADE

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

In Reading, students will learn how weather changes from day to day and from season to season. Through texts and collaborative work, children will explore types of weather they may experience quite often, or may never experience- such as blizzards or hurricanes. Students will also learn to notice how the weather affects them and their communities.

In Writing, students will write poems about how weather affects them. They will think about how weather impacts what you do, what you wear, and how it helps you decide what to do that day.

## MATH

In Topic 9, students will understand place value and count by hundreds to 1,000. They will use place-value blocks and drawings to model and write 3-digit numbers. Students will also read and write 3-digit numbers in expanded form, standard form, and word form.

Students will skip count by 5s, 10s, and 100s using a number line. They will also compare 3 digit numbers using place value.



## SCIENCE/SOCIAL STUDIES

In Science, students will continue to learn about animals and their habitats. In Social Studies, students will learn about New York City over time. They will learn about the geography of New York City and how maps help us.
