ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

In reading, students will learn ways to listen to each other and work out disagreements. Through reading and collaboration, students will learn to see different points of view. Then they will be able to understand why people may disagree and why sometimes that might be okay.

In writing, students will continue to learn how it is important to explain your point of view on an issue. They will state their point of view on an issue and provide evidence about why others should support their point of view.
